Dear Parent/Guardian

As part of our continued efforts to raise pupil achievement here at Ysgol Gyfun Cwm Rhondda, I should like to take the opportunity to remind you of the school's attendance procedures.

If a child is ill and unable to attend school, we kindly ask that parents contact school to inform us, and stating the reasons for the absence. In line with the Local Authority's policy, we ask that contact is made each day of the child's absence, please - not just the first day of illness.

If a child needs a medical appointment, once again in line with the Local Authority's policy, we ask that the school office is provided with official evidence of any such appointments please. This could take the form of an appointment card or prescription paper, in line with the Local Authority's policy.

Whenever possible, we kindly ask that any non-urgent appointments are arranged outside school time.

Although the school office records instances of late attendance on our electronic registration system, we kindly ask that parents/guardian's contact the school immediately to inform us of any late pupil arrivals.

If you are planning a family holiday during the school term, you must make a formal request to the Head Teacher **PRIOR** to booking any holiday.

From September 2014, the Local Authority has introduced a firmer approach to holidays during term time. Head Teachers will consider each request on its own merits and have the discretion to authorise or unauthorised every leave of absence period in line with the local authority guidelines set out below.
