A Level / AS Level Results Day Arrangements 10th August 2021

Dear Parent / Guardian,

I hope you've had an opportunity to enjoy the start of the summer break. Further to our letter at the end of the school year, I am writing to inform you of our arrangements as a school for the distribution of AS/A level results on August 10th. The school will be open on that day, but as a result of social distancing guidelines and health and safety rules we will not be distributing our results in the usual way.

Celebrating our pupils' results is an extremely important day in our school calendar, and we are proud to be able to come together as a community to celebrate the hard work and achievements of our young people. This year, however, we will not be able to allow pupils and their families to come together on the school grounds. In order to reduce the numbers on site we will issue A Level and AS Level separately, and **we kindly ask parents not to come to collect results with their child**. Instead, we ask you to park and stay in the main car park.

We kindly ask all pupils to adhere to these allocated time windows to ensure that as a school we can continue to adhere to necessary health and safety arrangements. We also ask pupils to wear face coverings and to adhere to social distancing guidelines.

Results Collection Arrangements Summer 2021

Year 13

- Results will be distributed = between 8.30 – 9.30am.
- Location = the Sports Hall

Year 12

- Results will be distributed = between 10.00 – 11.00am.
- Location = the Sports Hall

If you are unable to collect results on the day, you will be able to phone the school after 9am and a member of the Senior Leadership Team will be available to share the results with you.

As you are aware, the process of awarding calculated grades for pupils this year is based on a wide range of evidence / assessments, and the school has followed consistent and robust validation processes.

If the grade or grades awarded to you on results day are different to those previously issued to you by the school in July, you will be able to discuss this with a member of the SLT on the results day or by phoning the school or emailing (canlyniadau2021@ygcwmrhondda.cymru). We will try to respond to any query as soon as possible.

Members of the SLT will be present at the school **up to 12pm** on results day in order to offer support and advice to pupils about their learning pathways. Similarly, you will be able to phone the school up to 12pm if you, as parents, wish to discuss your child's results with us.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you, once again as a school, for your support during another challenging and unusual year, and to thank you in advance for committing yourself to the arrangements outlined in this letter.

For the parents of those pupils leaving us this year, as our pupils now move on to the next period in their lives, a heartfelt thanks for your support and your faith in us along the journey. I also thank you for your shared vision of the school, and for ensuring that your child contributes to the continuation of Welsh-medium education and the Welsh language in the Rhondda Valley. Remember, as part of the Ysgol Gyfun Cwm Rhondda family, our door will always be open to you.

We look forward to celebrating our pupils' achievements on August 10th.
