Forward

- The Cwm Rhondda transition plan is compliant with the new Welsh Statutory Instruments: 2022 No.566 (W. 131) Education, Wales, The Transition from Primary to Secondary School (Wales) Regulations 2022.
- It is a jointly agreed plan to develop the quality of transition for both pupils and schools and it addresses Schedule Regulation 6(3): 'Matters Which Must be Dealt With in Transition Plans', 2022 No.566 (W. 131) Education, Wales.
- Its primary aim is to ensure the smooth transition for pupils moving between primary and secondary schools, and to ensure that the needs of individual pupils are met regardless of ability or social background in keeping with national priorities, in particular the new Curriculum for Wales and ALN reform.

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this transition plan is to:

- coordinate and manage the smooth transition of pupils from primary to secondary
- promote a continuity in learning between primary and secondary through curriculum design, planning and teaching
- outline how individual pupils' progression will be supported as they transition from primary to secondary school
- outline proposals for supporting the individual wellbeing needs of pupils
- outline proposals for additional support for individual pupils identified as 'vulnerable', at risk or having additional learning needs
- set out the process for monitoring and evaluating the success of this transition plan in maximizing the continuity of learning and individual student progression
- ensure proper availability and use of student transfer data
- ensure parents / carers / families are fully informed of the transfer process

Cyflwyniad i Cwricwlwm Cwm Rhondda

- Am dros 4 mlynedd mae staff yr ysgol, dysgwyr, rhieni, gofalwyr a llywodraethwyr wedi gyrru'r newid tuag at gweledigaeth a realiti Cwricwlwm Cwm Rhondda. Mae'r gwaith yn deilluo o weithgorau staff, cyngor yr ysgol ac holiaduron i ddysgwr, rhieni a gofalwyr.
- O fewn y cyflwyniad hyn fe welwyd blas o'r profiadau health fydd dysgwyr Blwyddyn 7 Cwm Rhondda yn ei dderbyn yn ystod tymor yr Hydref.

- During the past 4 years staff, learners, governors and parents have been working together to turn the vision of "Cwricwlwm Cwm Rhondda" into a reality.
- This presentation provides a brief insight into some of the learning experiences our pupils in Year 7 will have during the Autumn term in Ysgol Gyfun Cwm Rhondda.
- Each area of learning has developed their curriculum with the skills that are integral to
 developing the four purposes, whilst developing cross-curricular skills in literacy, numeracy,
 digital competence, relationships and sexuality education, human rights education, diversity
 and work-related experiences.
- By the summer of 2024, the school's assessment and reporting procedures will allow a clear understanding of pupil progression.


